- 1. Members voted to approve the minutes of the telephone town hall general membership meeting held April 17, 2024.

- c. President Hanley informed members about the upcoming Stewards' Conference, and the record number of stewards who have registered to attend.
- d. President Hanley recognized the participation of 130 stewards from across Ontario in our Spring Stewards' Training program.
- e. 1006A members participated in Pride events in Brockville,
 Toronto and London. Members were encouraged to participate in Ottwa Pride.
- f. President Hanley recognized the participation of young workers in UFCW Canada's National Youth Worker Intership Program.
- 4. Secretary-Treasurer Kevin Benn presented the 2023 audited financial report. The report was voted on and approved by the membership.
- 5. Mark Hennessy, Special Assistant to the National President of UFCW Canada, spoke about the potential of an early provincial election and key issues that impact workers. These include affordability, housing and healthcare. He said politics affects every part of our lives and every voice matters.
