#### **ELIGIBILITY:**

Local 1000A members and their children/ dependents enrolled in any year of fulltime undergraduate studies at a Canadian university, college, or other recognized post-secondary educational institutions. Past winners will not be considered, even if enrolled in a different program or institution.

### APPLICANTS MUST SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING:

- **A.** Fully and correctly completed application form (overleaf) with evidence that either the applicant or the parent, legal guardian, or spouse of the applicant is and has been a member in good standing of UFCW Canada Local 1000A for a period of at least 6 months prior to the deadline for the application;
- **B.** Proof of acceptance to the institution and the program described in the application, as evidenced by copies of documentation from the institution such as letter of acceptance, enrolment, registration receipt, letter from the registrar, etc., as appropriate.

# PICK ONE OF THE FOLLOWING OPTIONS: SUBMISSION MUST BE ORIGINAL

Design ONE 8.5"x11" (letter sized) poster marking ONE of the following events:

Option 1: Labour Day
Option 2: Day of Mourning
Option 3: Equal Pay Day

Create and submit an imaginative, clever and original one-minute video on the following topic. It can be in any style – mini-documentary or like a TV ad.

**Topic:** Unions are about workers coming together to create fairness in the workplace and community. How do unions benefit Canadian families, workplaces and communities?

# A 500-word, typed essay answering ONE of the following questions:

**Question 1:** Income inequality is on the rise in Canada, as the poorer get poorer and as the rich get richer. The attacks on unions over recent decades have contributed to this growing gap. Why should Canadians care about the growing income inequality in our country and how are unions necessary in building a fairer society for everyone?

**Question 2:** By getting involved in your union, you can gain new skills and help strengthen your position at the bargaining table. Many young workers do not know this. What can your union (Local 1000A) do to get young workers interested and involved in the union? What type of events/initiatives should the union undertake to encourage more participation and interest?

**Question 3:** In a society where women and men are seen to be equal, the gender wage gap continues to grow. How can we inform and mobilize the general public to help eliminate the gender wage gap. What role do unions play in eliminating the gender wage gap?
